- Venetsanos Winery: Perched above the port of Athinios, Venetsanos Winery not only offers exceptional wines but also an intriguing history as the first industrial winery on the island.

## **Wine Tours**

 Many companies offer organized wine tours that include visits to several wineries, tastings, and sometimes meals. These tours are a great way to explore Santorini's wine culture and sample a variety of local wines.

### **Local Wine Varieties**

- **Assyrtiko**: A dry, full-bodied white wine with high acidity, often noted for its mineral flavors.
- **Nykteri**: Traditionally harvested at night to preserve the grapes' freshness, this wine is a blend of Assyrtiko and other local varieties, known for its complex and rich taste.
- **Vinsanto**: A sweet dessert wine made from sun-dried grapes, offering flavors of dried fruit, nuts, and honey.

Greek is the official language, but English is widely spoken in tourist areas.

## Currency

The currency is the Euro (€). Credit cards are widely accepted, but it's advisable to carry some cash for smaller establishments.

### **Best Time to Visit**

The best time to visit Santorini is from early April to early November, with July and August being the peak tourist months. For a quieter experience, consider visiting in May or September.
